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
Map Projections

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Motivation

map projection


point on reference surface (e.g. sphere, ellipsoid) is mapped to plane



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


 \rightarrow different map projections cause different distortions



mercator projection

map areas between lines of constant latitude/longitude to rectangles that preserve aspect ratios.




Motivation

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
- \rightarrow angles are preserved
- \rightarrow areas are distorted (esp. close to poles)





cylindrical equal-area projection

map areas between lines of constant latitude/longitude to rectangles of the same sizes.







cylindrical equal-area projection

map areas between lines of constant latitude/longitude to rectangles of the same sizes.

- \rightarrow distorted aspect ratios
- \rightarrow distorted angles
